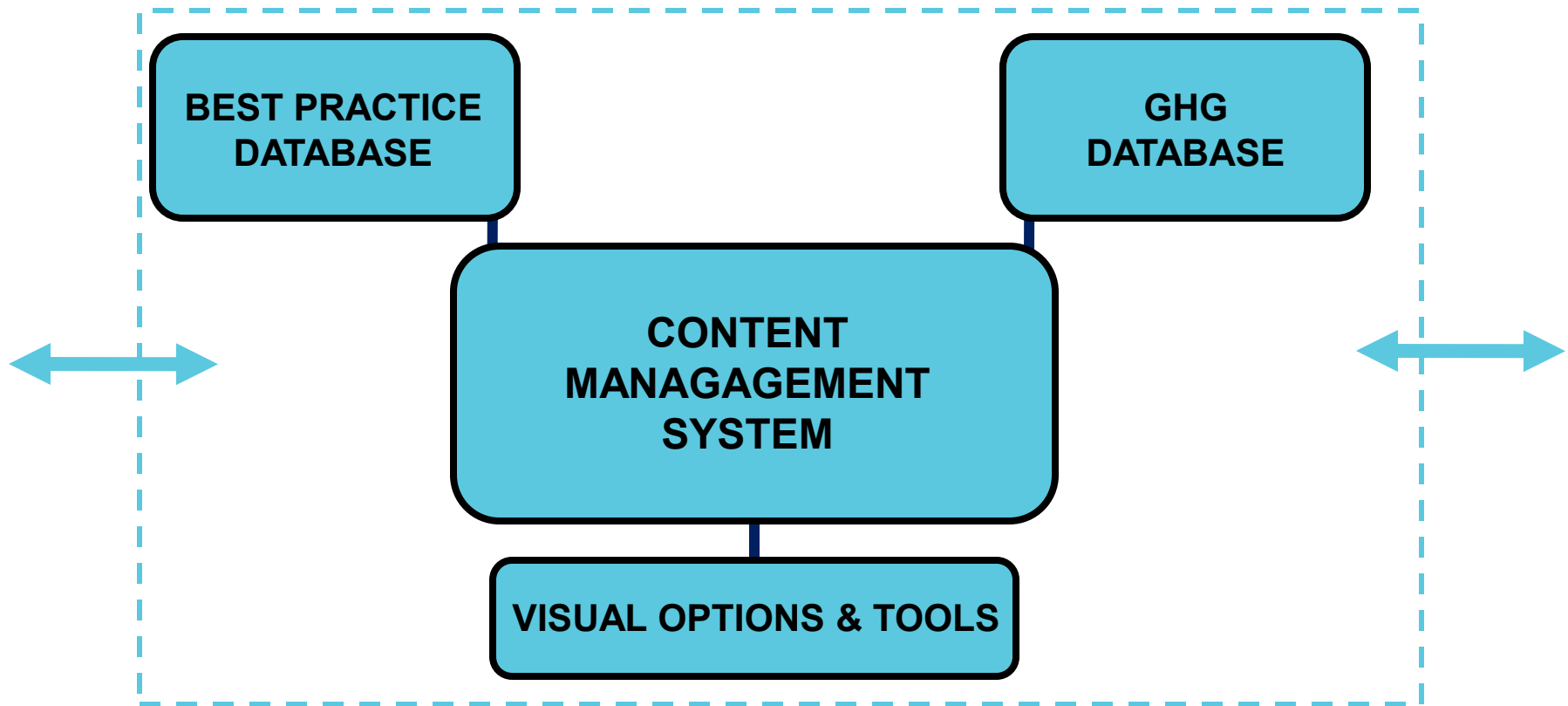

CATCH Elements – What it does



- CMS - Content Management System
- Portal – Content on CATCH =intelligent (active, real-time, multi-media, with embedded workflows (processes, behavioural rules)
- Extremely configurable (by distributed, active XML documents)
- Easy for user to personalise it – organise content created by someone else, locally or remotely, or users' own content.

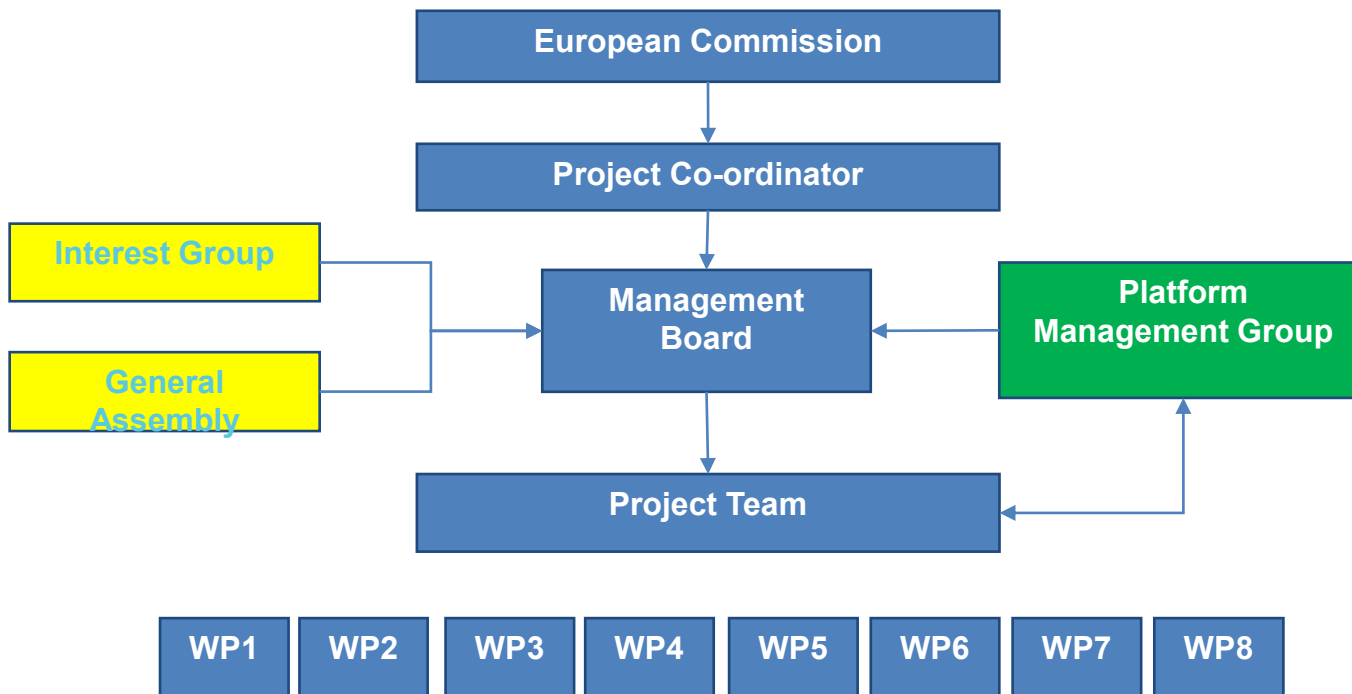

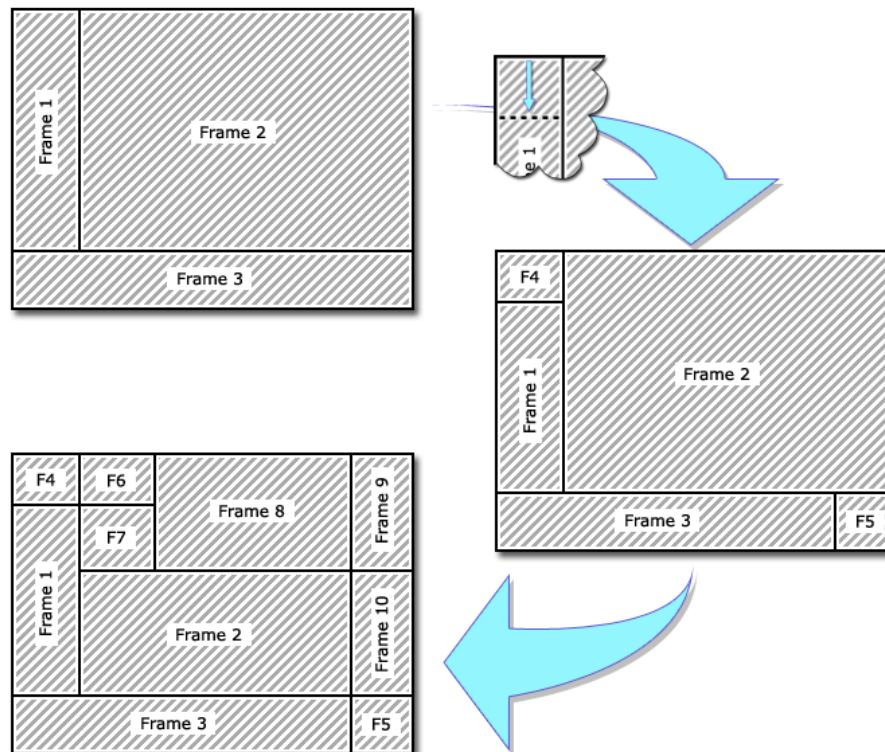

- CATCH offers users WYSIWYG frameset editor

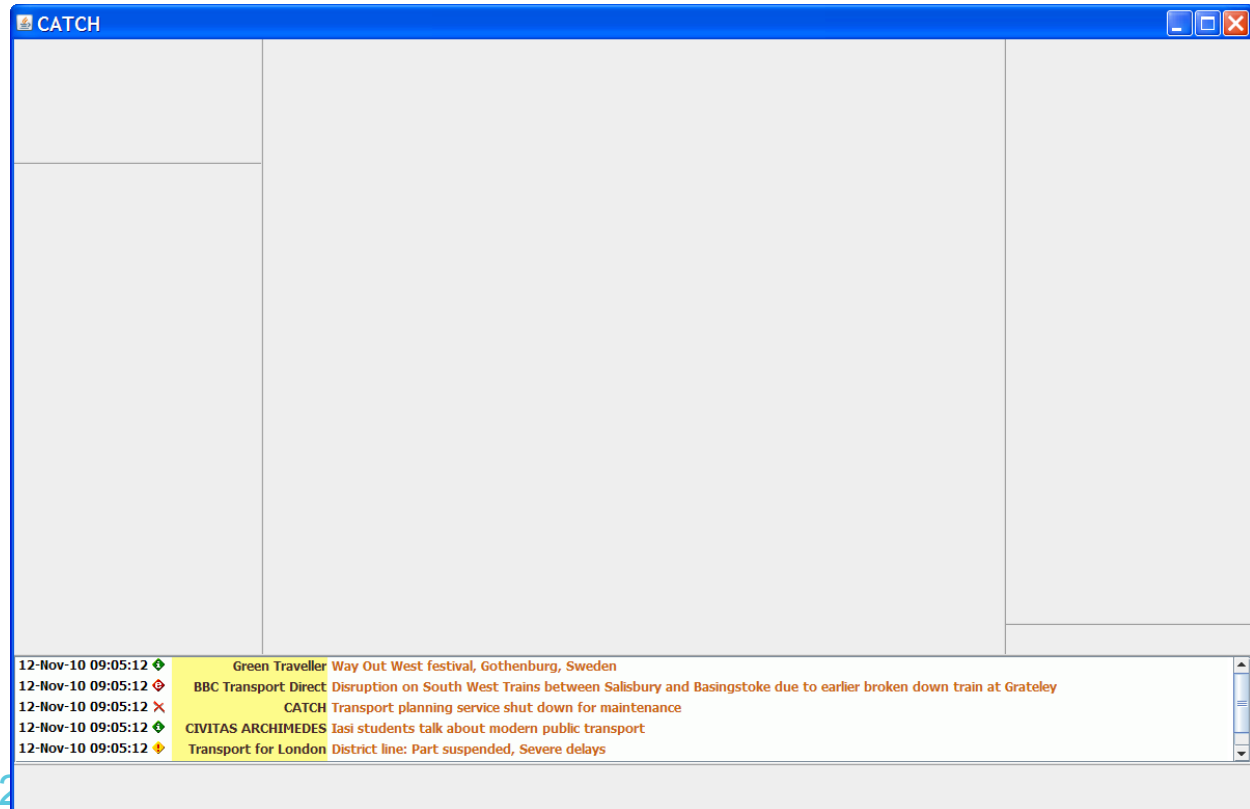
